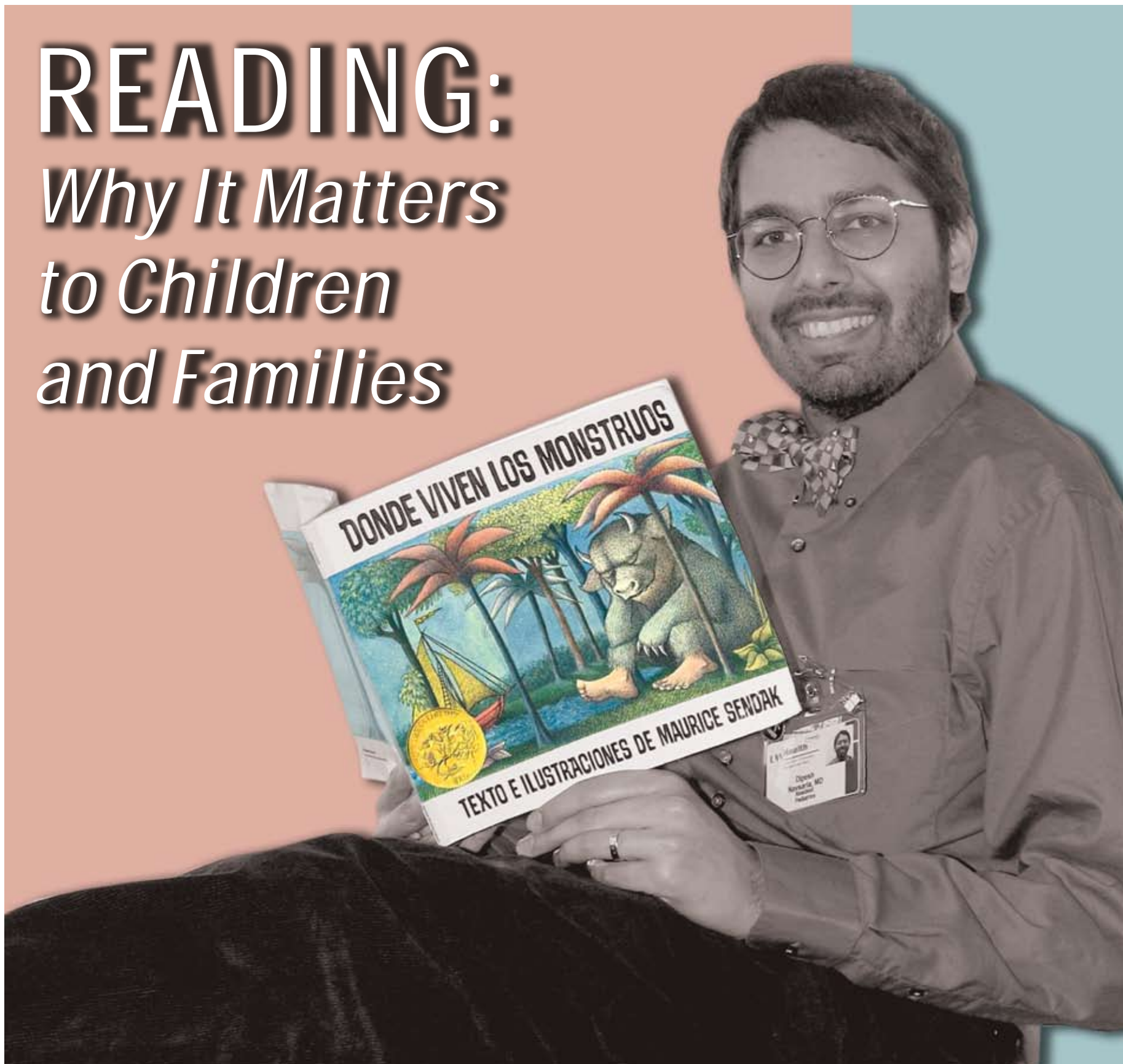


READING: *Why It Matters to Children and Families*
