How do you make stop motion videos?

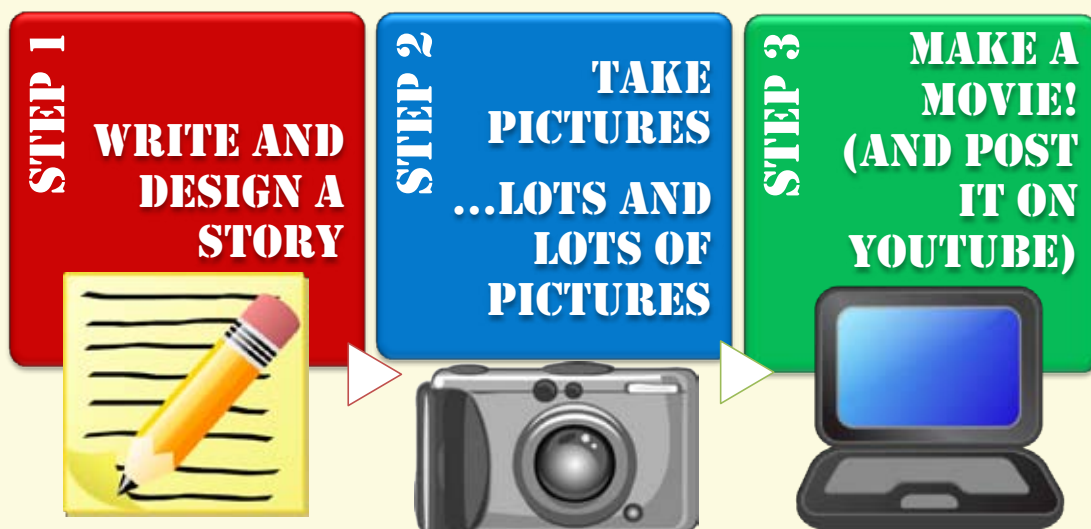
