What Will You Need?

1. A computer with an Internet connection
2. A cable to connect your eBook reader to your computer
3. The OverDrive Media Console software
<http://www.overdrive.com/software/omc/>
4. The Adobe Digital Editions software
<http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/>

After you install the software, Adobe Digital Editions will ask you to log in with your Adobe ID. If you do not have one, you'll need to create one at <http://adobe.ly/ch3cQS>

5. Your eBook reader

Once you've installed the software, you're ready to go to www.mymediamall.net

Finding an eBook You Want

Type a title or author into the search box at the top left of the page - OR - Click on [Advanced Search](#)

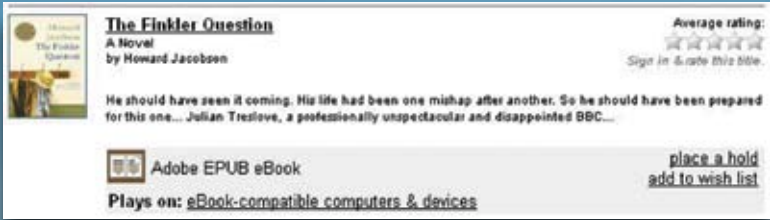


The Advanced Search allows you to limit your search to one of the available Adobe eBook formats

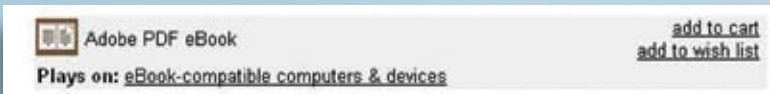


Is It Available or Checked Out?

When you find a book you want, it may give you one of three options:



1. Place a hold means the book is checked out and you can request to be notified when a copy is available for you.



2. Add to cart means the book is available!



3. Sign in to check availability means you need to sign in to see if copies are available or checked out. Once you sign in, you'll get either add to cart or place a hold option.

Add to cart will put the title in your cart and give you the option to continue browsing or proceed to checkout.

Proceed to checkout, place a hold, and sign in to check availability will take you to the sign in screen.



Signing In

The Urbana Free Library is not listed in the drop down menu for Library. We are members of MyMediaMall through the Illinois Heartland Library System, which you should select from the list.



Enter your Library card number and PIN in the corresponding boxes. Your PIN is usually the last four digits of your phone number.

Placing a Hold

1. Click on place a hold and sign in
2. Enter you email address



3. You'll receive an email when the title is available for checkout

Checking Out

1. Click on add to cart

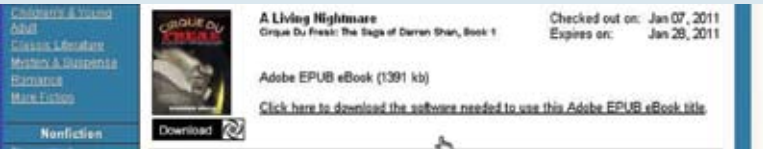


2. Select your checkout period from the drop down menu

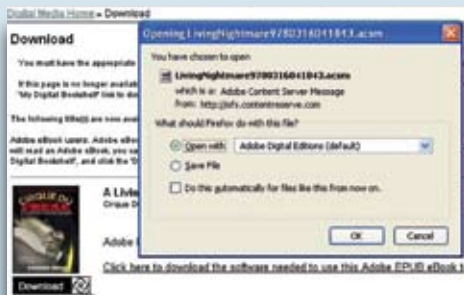


3. Click on Confirm check out

4. Click on Download



5. If prompted to select a program, choose Adobe Digital Editions



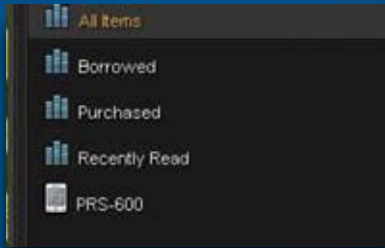
6. Adobe Digital Editions should automatically open and download your book



Moving Book to Device

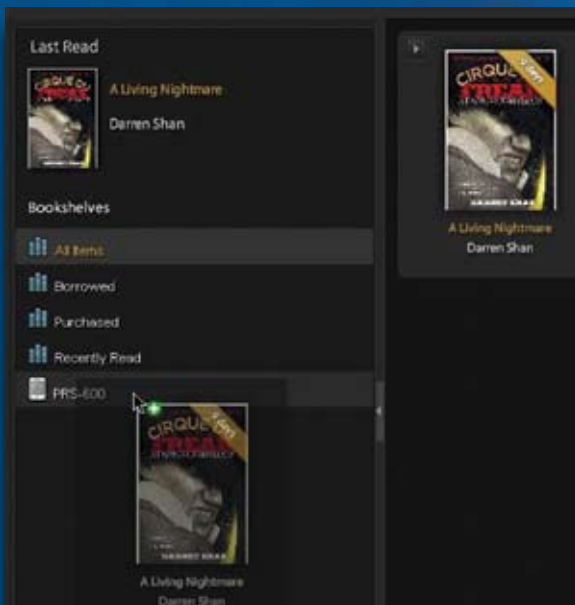
Plug your eBook reader into the computer, if it is not already connected

Once your computer recognizes the device, it should appear on the list on the left side of Adobe Digital Editions



In Adobe Digital Editions, make sure the Library icon is selected

Now, click-and-drag your eBook title to your device. Hover over your device and release once it's highlighted. Adobe Digital Editions should display a loading timer while the eBook is copied to your reader.



To make sure the book has transferred, click on your device. You should see any eBooks on the device displayed on the right.

Disconnect your device and enjoy reading your eBook!
